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1 Protection of personal data

At Bunnik Plants Beheer B.V. we process personal data. Personal data is all data concerning an identified or an identifiable natural person. We process your personal data with due observance of the appropriate regulations. In this privacy statement we will explain how we, as controller, will handle your personal data.

2. Who this privacy statement is meant for

This privacy statement is meant for:

- Our customers;
- People who physically visit our company and whose personal data is being registered;
- Those who receive our newsletters and e-mails;
- Possible customers with whom we have, or would like to have contact;
- Our suppliers;

This privacy statement is <u>not</u> meant for our employees, hired personnel and job applicants.

3. The personal data we process

We process personal data that you yourself have provided us with and data which we have obtained through other means (such as, through social media-platforms or public registers).

Below you will find an overview of the types of personal data we process:

- Name and surname;
- Address information;
- Telephone number;
- E-mail address;
- Location data;
- Bank account details;
- Language of communication (preferential)

We do not intentionally collect the (personal) data of those under the age of 16 who visit our website. We cannot however, check whether a visitor is over the age of 16

We recommend parents to be involved in their children's online activities in order to prevent the collection of (personal) data – without the possibly required parental consent – of those under 16. *Consent

*** Legitimate Interest

Processing your personal data is necessary for pursuing our legitimate interests, or that of a third party, except when your interests, or fundamental rights or freedoms which require the protection of personal data, outweigh our interests.

**** Legal Obligation

Processing your personal data is necessary to comply with a legal obligation entrusted upon us.

5. Automated decision-making

We do not have access to software or computer systems which – by automated processing of personal data – make decisions about affairs which can have a (significant) impact on the individual. These are decisions made by software or computer systems without any human involvement (for instance one of our employees).

6. How long do we retain personal data?

We do not retain your personal data any longer than absolutely necessary for realising the purpose for which your data is being kept. We use the following retention period for the following (categories) of personal data:

7. Sharing personal data with third-parties

We will only share your personal data with third-parties, if this is consistent with the purpose or purposes for which the data was collected. We will conclude a data processor agreement with companies we have commissioned to process your data, in order to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality regarding your data. We will however remain responsible for all such processing.

Transmission to parties outside of the European Economic Area (EEA) It might be necessary to share your personal data with parties outside of the European Economic Area (EEA). Whenever this is the case, we will only share your personal data with parties outside of the EEA, if they can ensure at least the same level of security as we do.

8. Cookies, or similar technologies that we use

A cookie, is a small text-file which is stored on your devices the first time you visit this website. We use technical, functional and tracking cookies. The technical and functional cookies are necessary for the operation of the website and its user-friendliness. They make sure that the website works as intended and remember for instance, your preferred settings. These cookies are also used to optimise the website. Furthermore, we use cookies which track your browsing behaviour, in order to provide you with content and advertisement that are tailored to your interest. We have already informed you about these cookies and asked permission to place them, the first time you visited our website. You can opt out of these cookies, by setting your browser so it will no longer save these cookies. You can also delete all previously saved information through the settings of your browser.

Cookies by third parties – such as advertisers and/or social media companies – are also placed on our website.

9. Security

We take the protection of your personal data very seriously and take appropriate measures to protect your data against misuse, loss, unauthorised access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorised alterations. 10. View, rectify and/or delete your personal data, and complaints

On the basis of the privacy regulations, you have the (conditional) right to:

- Withdraw your consent for the data processing (however, this does not mean that the personal data that has been processed before this withdrawal, have no longer legally been processed);
- Object to us processing your data;
- Limit us processing your personal data;
- Let us send you or a third-party appointed by you, your data in the form of a computer file (the right to data portability).

You can send a request to view, correct, delete, limit, transfer your personal data or request to withdraw your consent for or object to the processing of your personal data to <u>info@bunnikcreations.nl</u>. In order to be certain that a request is indeed made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your proof of identity (passport, ID-card or drivers licence) with your request. In this copy, please black out your photo, MRZ ("machine readable zone", the numbered strip at the bottom of the proof of identification), document number and social security number. We will respond to your request as soon as possible.
